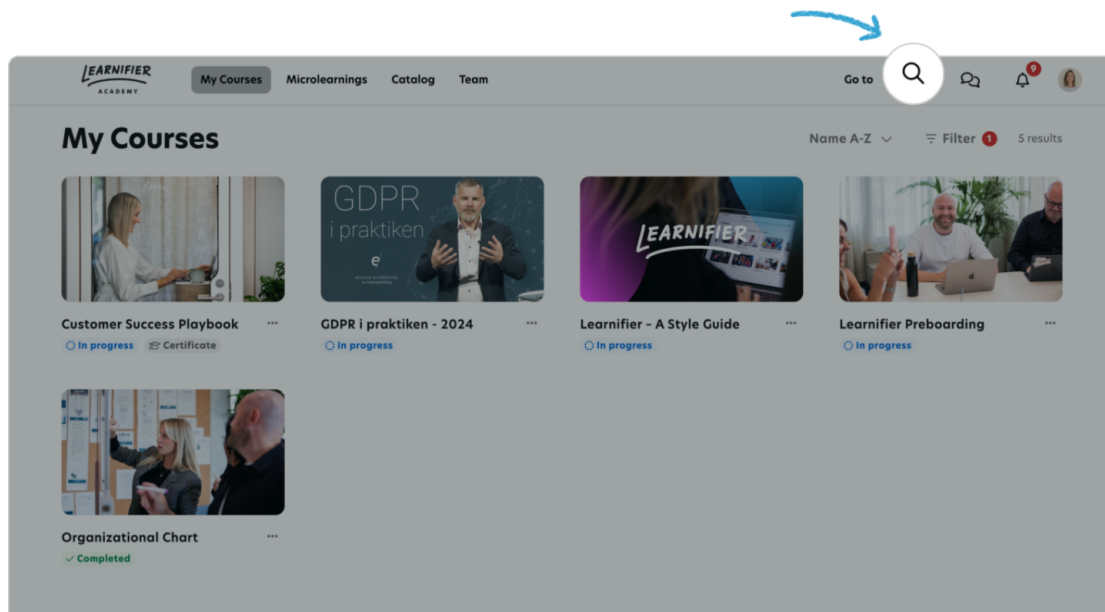

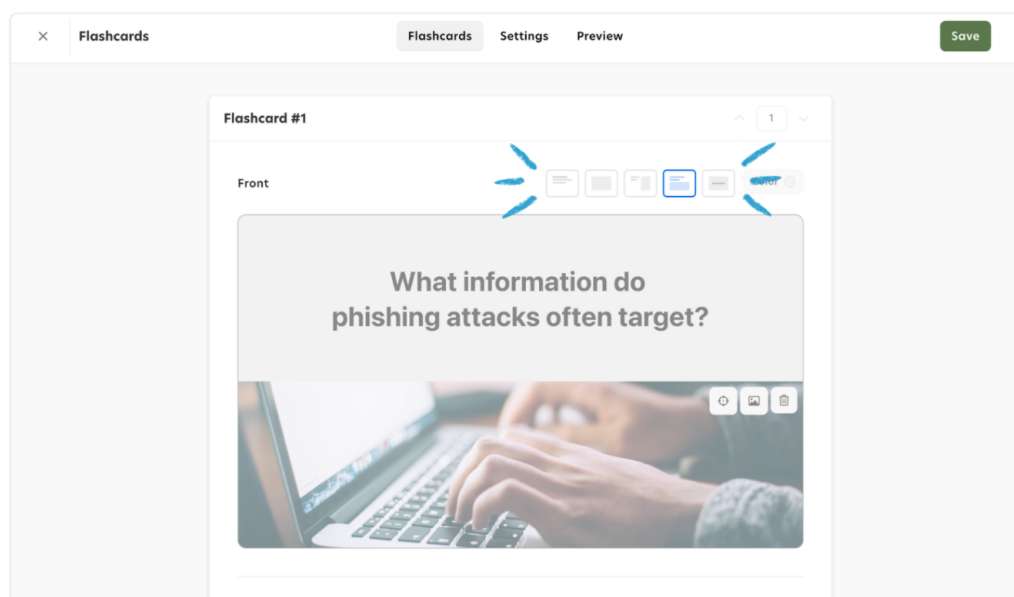


Flashcard Templates

Catalog Template Permissions

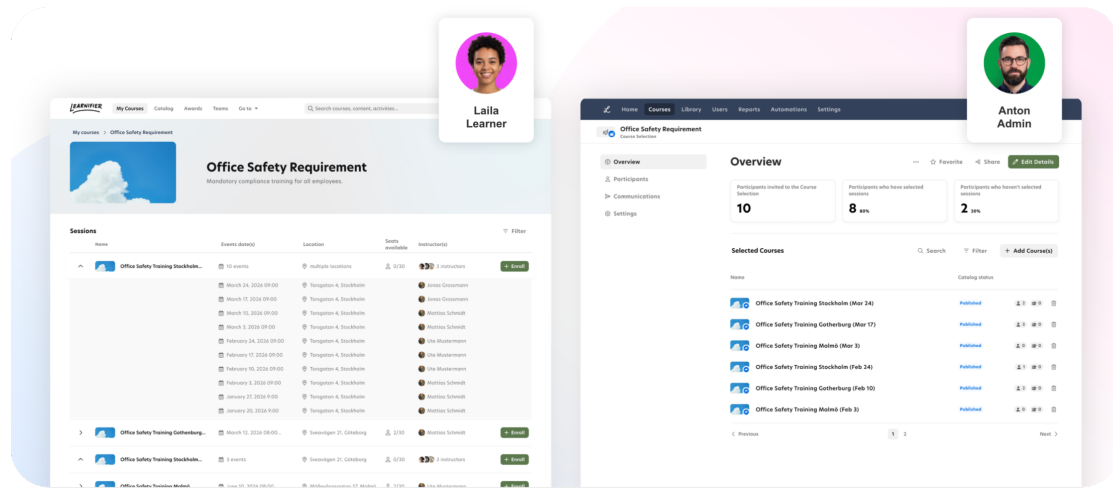
