## The time is near! Final Launch of the New Learner Experience - March 11!



Optimized Course View - A cleaner, more focused layout that makes it easier to navigate and engage with course content.
Streamlined Learning Flow - A collapsible step progress and more intuitive placement of resources make it easier to move through the course.
